

Reverse Appliqué Class Supplies and Pre-Class Prep

Students can make any of the Pacific Rim 2-Fabric quilts. Carol has made the Sea Turtle, Dragonfly, Sea Horse and Hibiscus. Carol teaches her tips/short-cuts for fusible, raw-edge machine appliqué (see note below **). Carol believes the Sea Turtle and Dragonfly are the easiest.

In class, you'll complete Phase-1: pattern marking, cutting out and fusing the quilt top, and Carol will demo how to secure appliqués using machine stitching.

Carol's Supply List and Prep:

Pre-Wash and Press All Fabrics. Carol recommends the quilt top fabrics have good contrast with each other, but not too much contrast within the fabrics. Pre-washed Batiks are recommended for the top fabrics. (Tighter weave results in less fraying of raw-edge appliqué)

Class Supplies (Phase-1):

- 1 yard light Batik fabric
- 1 yard medium to dark Batik fabric
- (Fabric for Phase 2-3: ¾ yard Backing)
- 1-1/3 yards of 18" wide steam-a-seam 2 (or steam-a-seam-2 lite) OR 2 yards 12" wide steam-a-seam
- 5"-8" scissors for fabric and paper
- Marker for writing on steam-a-seam paper
- Sewing Machine is not necessary for class
- *Phase 2-3 requires additional supplies.* See Pacific Rim Quilt patterns for complete Supply List.

**NOTE: Carol teaches her tips/short-cuts for fusible, raw-edge machine appliqué, and does not cover/support hand, needle turn, or hand embellished methods. Instructions for hand, needle turn appliqué are included in the Pacific Rim Quilt pattern instructions.
